Portieres are unique curiosities produced by Cambridge Glass Company workers prior to 1930.

Each link is a Cambridge color representative of the early 1920's. This portiere resided in the home of the worker who made it until he sold it to Phyllis and Bill Smith, founding members of the National Cambridge Collectors. The colors include Azurite, Helio, Ivory, Mulberry, Emerald, Royal Blue, and Topaz, among others.
